What is the Godot Engine?

Godot is a powerful, free, and open-source game engine.

It is a flexible platform for developing games and interactive applications, maintained by a global network of contributors. Godot is distributed under the MIT license and gives developers full ownership and control of their projects - no licensing fees, no paywalls, no vendor lock-in with the guarantee that it will stay like this forever.

It's a favorite among indie developers, but it's also used by studios and tech companies of all sizes to build games and other software.

The project is stewarded by the **non-profit Godot Foundation**, which supports development and community growth through a small team of dedicated people handling project management, marketing, and more.

What is GodotFest?

GodotFest is a new annual community event celebrating the Godot Engine and its ecosystem. It is organized by a small team of passionate Godot nerds with support and backing of the Godot Foundation and many volunteers. The founding team of the GodotFest were also the core team of GodotCon 2023 in Munich, which was very well received.

Our goal is to bring together:

- · Knowledge-sharing with workshops and talks
- A shared mission to elevate Godot-powered projects and strengthen the community & ecosystem

Who's Behind GodotFest?

After organizing the highly successful GodotCon Munich 2023, our team gained invaluable experience - both as event organizers and active participants in GodotCon Berlin 2024. Part of the team also volunteered there, either organising or as speakers. We realized that, to better serve the needs of the community and event logistics, it makes sense to organize GodotFest independently, while still maintaining a close relationship with the Godot Foundation.

Why independent?

- The Godot Foundation is a non-profit with a core focus: coordinating & enabling engine development.
- It operates under strict donation guidelines and administrative constraints (e.g. tax/VAT).
- Event-specific needs like flexible vendor contracts or providing food and swag require a more agile structure.
